New Melton Hospital Gets Go Ahead

Kororoit Creek Facelift

Kororoit Creek is set to get a major facelift and Modeina residents are set to enjoy significant new lifestyle amenities thanks to landscaping works scheduled to commence early this year.

These works incorporate the first two sections of a significant creekside rehabilitation program that is being completed in five sections.

Along with planting of 175,000 predominantly native plants, the works will include development of extensive pathways, sheltered BBQ facilities, fitness stations, a viewing platform, seating and a playground.

These works mark the commencement of significant creekside rehabilitation and will enable residents to enjoy the natural creek frontage, alongside a healthy lifestyle with the future pathway connections, fitness stations and play/social facilities, whilst enjoying the rich significant historical and cultural significance of the area.

Traditional Owner Groups were consulted and provided input into the design elements and materials of the shelter, while specialist ecologists advised on appropriate planting species and density in growling grass frog areas and protected native vegetation areas.

The first section runs alongside completed residential stages from 12C to Stage 17. The second section borders completed residential stages 14 and 16 in the southern section of Modeina.

Residents can look forward to the completion of landscaping works on the first two sections later in 2020.

Burnside Primary School Set To Soar In 2020!

Burnside Primary School has had an exciting first year, successfully embedding the vision to build a school culture that demonstrates a strong belief in and a commitment to providing a rich and rigorous curriculum with a safe, secure learning environment.

"With a clear focus on catering for the diverse range of students in a supportive, nurturing and challenging learning environment, students are at the centre and purpose of all that we do," says Principal Davide Lombardi.

The curriculum, delivered in a positive, stimulating and challenging learning environment where every student experiences success and develops a love of life-long learning has been evident with the enrolments for the year 2020 set to reach around 170 enrolments for 2020, (which includes 60 preps) up from 90 students in 2109.

"We are looking forward to the student population growing exponentially this year and in future years, whilst we still maintain our rich sense of community" explains Mr. Lombardi.

2019 saw many exciting and community-based initiatives such as the Lifelong Learning Festival in October, during which Burnside Primary School opened its doors to the community to discover what every day learning looks like for the kids on campus. An art show showcasing student work and a school tour was capped off with a sausage sizzle and the screening of The Lego Movie 2.

New Melton Hospital Gets Go Ahead

With the west booming, the City of Melton is at the heart of this growth and with the community expected to reach 200,000 in the next five years, so does the growth demands in health services of the community and surrounding areas.

Modeina residents are set to benefit after the Victorian Government announced recently that the brand new, 24-hour Melton Hospital is one step closer with the state's largest public health service providers Western Health appointed to manage the cutting-edge 24-hour medical facility.

"Melton's new hospital will be in trusted hands. Western Health has a proud track record providing the highest quality care to patients throughout Melbourne's booming western suburbs," said Acting Minister for Health, Martin Foley in a recent release.

The Victorian Government has invested \$2.4 million to complete a business case for the world-class hospital in Melbourne's north west. Initial planning is now underway, with a principal consultant to be chosen, and master planning to commence this year.

This planning incorporates detailed investigation into the health needs of the region and will determine the new hospital's location, size and what range of services it needs to provide.

This vital research will ensure the new Melton Hospital meets the growing needs of the region now, and into the future. Stay tuned for future updates as plans progress.
